

EARMUFF

Cleaning & Maintenance

Cushions should be wiped clean after each use Cushions & foam pads should be washed in warm soapy water at least once a week It is recommended to check cushions and foam pads for damage as these may deteriorate with use Replace earmuffs as and when necessary

NOTE: for optimum performance, the cups of the earmuff must completely cover your ears and should seal tightly against the head. Anything that interferes with the seal such as long hair, thick or poorly fitting spectacles, pencils, or caps will lessen the protection. Do not bend or reshape the head-band as this will cause a loose fit and sound leakage.
